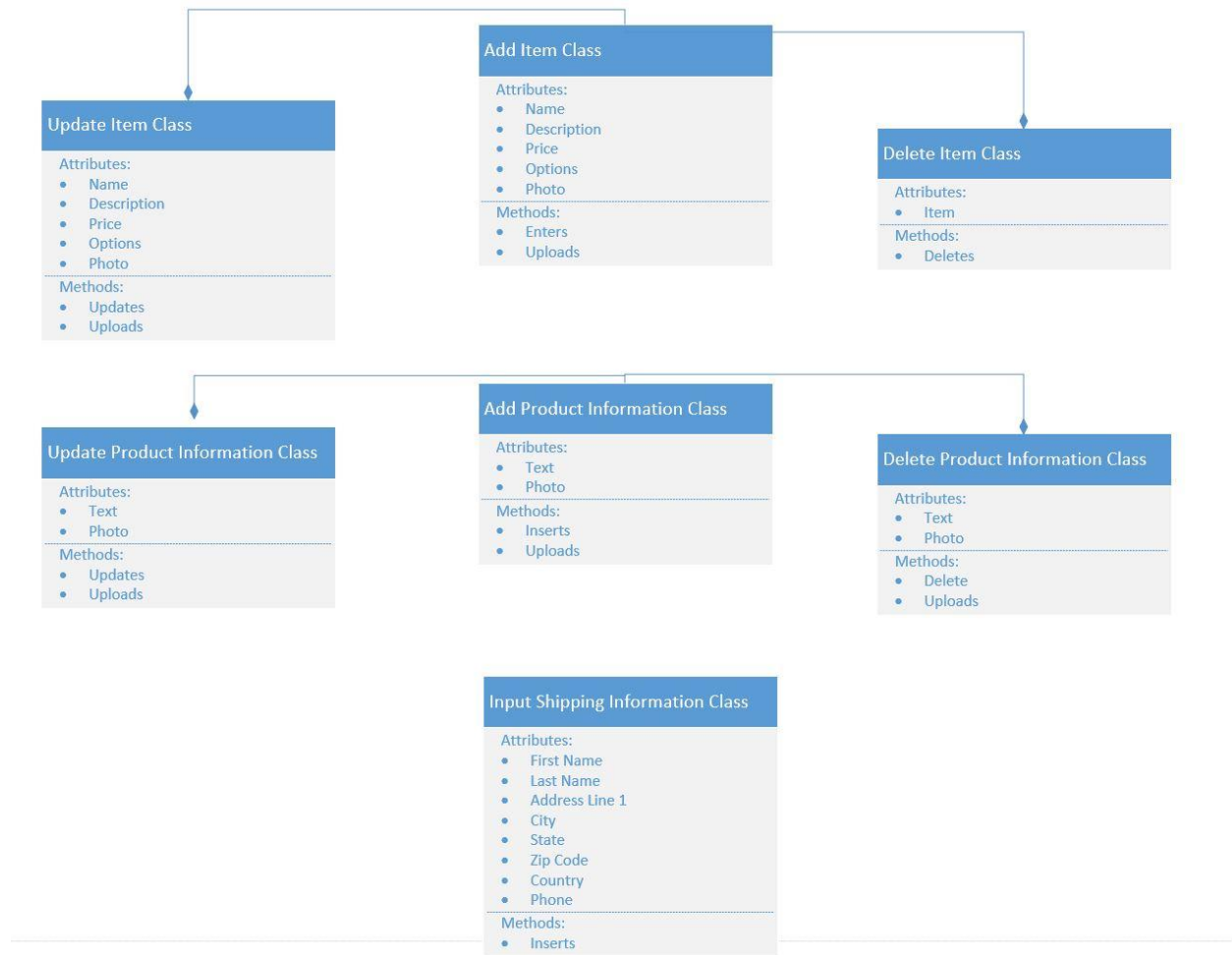


# Class Diagram



## Narrative:

The above photo shows an outline of a class diagram. A class diagram is composed of individual classes. Each class has attributes and has methods. For instance, the Add Item class has 5 attributes. These attributes are to show where data would need to be stored, such as the price of an item. Below that are methods. Methods is how a person or system interacts with a class. It allows the user/system to do something, like enter information or upload a photo. The lines in this photo show how a class may interact with another class. For instance, you cannot delete an item or update an item if an item has not been created to begin with. The same can be said for updating or deleting product information.
