



# Prototypes:

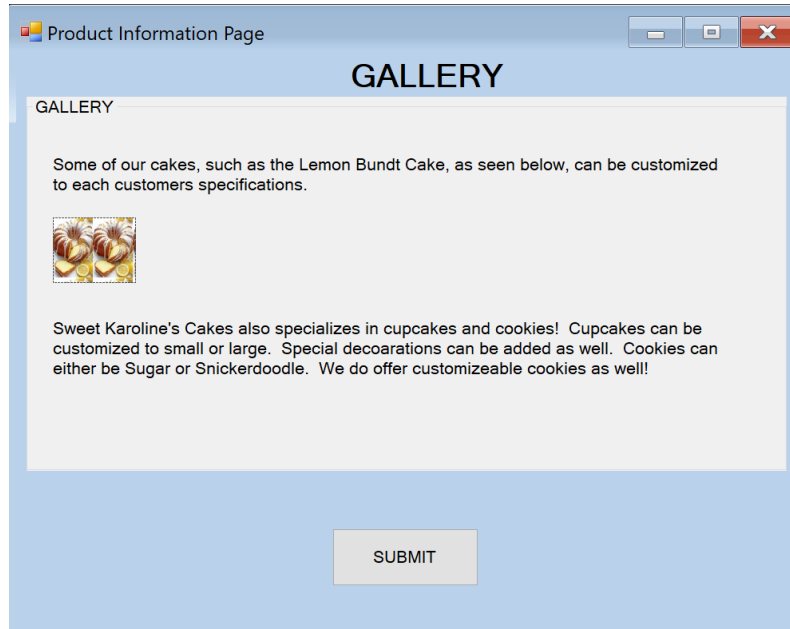
The above prototype shows a mockup of what a create an item page would look like. This would require Karoline to enter the required fields into the appropriate text boxes and upload a photo of the item.



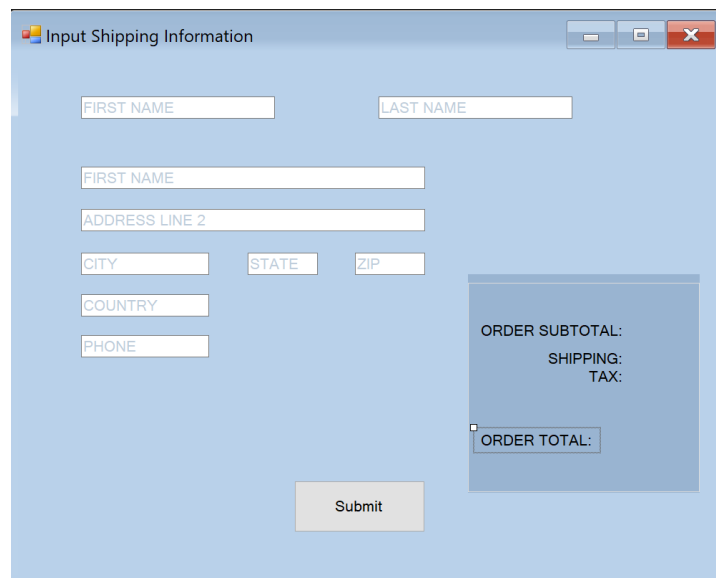
